






## *Ideal Timeline for Your Wedding Day Photography*


 *Dress & Details* – 30 minutes – Time to get the perfect photos of the dress, rings, shoes, bouquets, and the other details of the day.


 *Preparation* – 1 to 2 hours – This is a great time for getting close ups of the bridal party on hair and makeup, everyone preparing and getting dressed, and lots of candid and emotional moments.


 *The First Look* - 30 to 45 minutes – During this time, you can enjoy seeing each other for the first time on the wedding day. This could be Father/Daughter moment too. This also allows extra time to spend on couple/individual portraits.

 *Ceremony* – 30 to 90 minutes – This time needed for the ceremony can vary greatly according to your cultural and personal preferences.

 *Family Formals* – 45 to 60 minutes – Formals should take around 45 minutes to 1 hour depending on the size of your family and number of guests. Plan on 3-5 minutes per group on the average.

 *The Wedding Party* – 45 to 60 minutes – Time for the fun stuff! We will get a variety of photos in creative and styled poses focused on great expressions and lighting with your nearest and dearest.

 *The “Happy Couple”* – 45 to 60 minutes – Happy couple photos should be around 1 hour and ideally take place 30 to 45 minutes before sunset. This is the best time to capture romantic, ambient lighting.

 *Reception* – 3 to 4 hours – Factor in the appropriate amount of time for toasts, dinner, cake cutting, milestone activities/dances and bonus photos with family and friends.
