



# St Patrick's Day Door hanger

## Free Pattern

## Supplies

felt craft sheets 2 in green and one in white

10 X 7" Paper backed fusible webbing

1/4" ribbon

Hot glue Optional

Start by printing two copies of the pattern. Cut the larger shape in green. Trace the smaller shape and the circle for hanging onto the paper backed fusible webbing. Cut out the shape and iron the paper onto the white felt sheet. After ironing it to the felt, cut the shape out.



Remove the paper and position the shape onto the green background. Iron it in place. Cut the green hanging circle to match the white one that is already cut. Using a decorative stitch or a straight stitch, sew around the edge of the white felt. I used a blanket stitch, but any stitch will work.



Transfer the stem stitching lines to the felt and sew these using straight stitch, or a triple stitch.



Using the leaf pattern, cut three leaves from green felt. With needle and knotted thread, hand sew two large stitches on each one as shown, stringing them together. Pull them together firmly and they will form the shamrock. Knot in place.



Position the shamrocks in place. Hot glue or hand sew in place. Add a ribbon bow at the bottom. You are finished!
